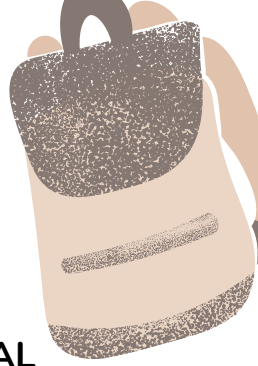


Emergency Go Bag
